This workshop with Prof. Patricia MacCormack serves as a forum to discuss newest developments in both queer and posthumanist thought, with a particular emphasis on the interrelation between these two fields. In addition, participants will have the opportunity to present their research projects and to discuss them with Prof. MacCormack and their peers. The workshop consists of two parts: the morning session will focus on the discussion of a selection of theoretical and critical texts by Rosi Braidotti as well as Prof. MacCormack herself; the afternoon session will be entirely devoted to the participants' research.

Patricia MacCormack is Professor of Continental Philosophy at Anglia Ruskin University. She is the co-editor of *Deleuze and the Schizoanalysis of Cinema* (2008), the editor of *The Animal Catalyst: Towards Ahuman Theory* (2014), and the author of *Cinesexuality* (2008) and *Posthuman Ethics: Embodiment and Cultural Theory* (2012).
